Permitted Tyre Brands for All Classes

Motorsport UK Championship Permit Number: CH2021/ R052 (Grade C)

Endurance Technical Regulations

- 5.15.1 It is a requirement that all vehicles competing in the championships must qualify and race on Goodyear **or Dunlop** branded tyres
- 5.15.3 It is a requirement that all entries run on Goodyear **or Dunlop** branded tyres only, unless a comparable size is not available. Such instances must be declared to the organisers at the time of entry for the Organisers' written agreement prior to the event as to the tyre brand and specifications, including compound[s]. The organisers' decision in this regard will be final and in their entire discretion.

Trophy Technical Regulations

- 5.15.1 It is a requirement that all vehicles competing in the championships must qualify and race on Dunlop Direzza or Goodyear **or Dunlop** branded wet tyres. In the event of **a suitable list 1b/1c tyre becoming available from Goodyear** during the season this tyre will also be acceptable following confirmation from Britcar-Endurance
- 5.15.3 It is a requirement that all entries run on Goodyear **or Dunlop** branded tyres only, unless a comparable size is not available. Such instances must be declared to the organisers at the time of entry for the Organisers' written agreement prior to the event as to the tyre brand and specifications, including compound[s]. The organisers' decision in this regard will be final and in their entire discretion.

Praga Technical Regulations

- 5.15.1 It is a requirement that all entries run on Goodyear **or Dunlop** branded tyres only, unless a comparable size is not available. Such instances must be declared to the organisers at the time of entry for the Organisers' written agreement prior to the event as to the tyre brand and specifications, including compound[s]. The organisers' decision in this regard will be final and in their entire discretion.
